


- Public Health

- Began sampling around Long Island







# Legend PSP Stations 2018

## **PSP Monitoring**

- Only 5 stations exceeded limit
  - 80ug/100g
  - Mussels only
- > 2018 blooms were 'small'
  - Present in May & June (one month)
- Regional Mussel closure
  - May 1


Alexandrium





## **ASP Monitoring**

- No samples over reg. limit in Casco Bay
- If any toxin was present, instated precautionary closure
  - DMR testing not specific enough to ID P.australis
- P. australis was present in 2018
- October-November
  - Shorter duration than 2017
  - Short-term open/close (~48hr)
    - 2019 plan to be more consistent



## **Phyto Monitoring**

- Precursor to shellfish testing
- Karenia present, but not bad in 2018
  - Fish/lobster/shellfish dye offs in 2017
