

## Maine Department Marine Resouces DMR Water Quality Stations in Casco Bay








- 226 sampling stations in 2019

- New aquaculturerelated testing sites











- Water Quality (fecal coliform) Testing
  - Bay water temperatures
  - Pathogens in marine waters
- Shoreline Surveys (coast ~250' from shore)
  - Includes land use changes over time
  - Working and failing septic systems
- Biotoxin Shellfish Testing
  - Biotoxin accumulation in shellfish
- Phytoplankton Monitoring
  - Persistence of harmful algal blooms, includes volunteer efforts
- ME/NH Inshore Trawl Survey
  - Health of marine ecosystem, trends in fish communities
- Landings Data
  - Harvest of marine resources, may have ecosystem health applications
- Coastal Program Mapping Initiatives
  - Marine habitat (seafloor) changes over time
