Methods and Data Sources

Conservation Lands

We used two data sets to analyze conservation lands. We downloaded MaineDACF geospatial Maine Conserved Lands data from the Maine GeoLibrary in February 2020. In April 2020, we obtained geospatial conservation lands data for coastal municipalities in Casco Bay from Bob Houston at the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Gulf of Maine Coastal Program. Although the two data sets use slightly different methods to classify conservation status, both data sets share a common definition of 'permanent' protected land.

We used ArcMap to prepare the watershed map of permanently protected conservation land. The map displays land classified as permanently protected in both data sets, but no other classification categories in either data set.

We exported Maine Conserved Lands tabular data to Excel and prepared summary statistics to create the Permanent Conservation Land in Casco Bay Watershed bar graph.

We used U.S. FWS Gulf of Maine Coastal Program geospatial data to prepare the Percentage of Land Area Permanently Conserved in Coastal Communities map. The map displays summary statistics provided to us in Excel by USFWS. The line graph showing Acres permanently conserved was also provided to us by USFWS.
